



CHURCH PLANTING and **PASTORAL MINISTRY**



Creating self-sustaining gospel communities through church plants, mentoring church planters, and gospel renewal for local pastors in need of revitalization

» In Tower Hamlets in London, Serge Missionaries Ross and Aislinn Meyer are planting a new church in a large, majority Muslim, South Asian community. This mostly unreached community has been home to various immigrant communities for centuries, and recently the South East Asian immigrants have been expressing a lot of interest in starting a church.

» In Latin America, our new Area Director Mark Berry and Serge Missionary **Chip Jones** are mentoring national pastors, helping them understand the gospel in deeper ways and have a vision for how their churches can impact their communities. As a result of their work, mentees have started to mentor other pastors in their region - setting off a chain reaction of renewal and church revitalization.

» Eric Brauer, Serge Area Director for Ireland and Europe, has completed a re-work of our Manual for Cross Cultural Mentoring of Church Planters. Rather than having a set curriculum, this manual will train our missionaries - and others outside our organization - to mentor national church planters and pastors in principles of grace, and to resource them based on their individual needs.

» In Granada, Spain, our church plant, "Reconciliacion," just celebrated its 10th **anniversary**. This church started out with a mostly immigrant population, and it was challenging to get local Spaniards to attend. But now, after 10 years, there is more Spanish participation and increased interest in local leadership than ever before which is very encouraging!

MEDICAL MISSIONS

Proclaiming the Gospel Through Medicine

» At Kibuye Hope Hospital in Burundi, Serge doctors are training and discipling local Burundian physicians during and post med school. They are instilling in them good medical practice with moral and ethical fiber, teaching them Christ-centered, compassionate care, which is crucial to the goal of changing the face of healthcare in Burundi.

» In Bundibugyo, Dr. Marc Carrigan sponsored the training of 12 nurses and midwives in the "Helping Babies Breathe Program," which targets the management of newborns in the first five minutes of life. This training will be lifesaving for so many.

» In Burundi, Drs. Eric and Rachel McLaughlin launched a new preventative care program, called "Zigama Mama," in an effort to reduce the unusually high number of uterine rupture (UR) cases per year. Local women have already joined in to take part in the life-saving program!

» Together, Kijabe Hospital in Kenya and Kibuye Hope Hospital in Burundi are performing over 6,503 combined surgeries a year – an unprecedented number. This huge effort is changing lives and serving the needy, sick and vulnerable in a tangible, powerful way.











Mentoring, training, and creating gospelcentered resources to help people become spiritually alive and engage their families, work and communities with gospel grace.

» In Germany, Eric and Karen Brauer have mentored several local church leaders in Sonship, and are training them to mentor others through Sonship. These church leaders have already begun to carry the work forward, by mentoring leaders throughout Germany and other nearby European countries.

» In America, through our new Church Leadership Development Program, we are helping church leaders integrate transformative gospel principles into every area of their ministries. This year, Pastor and Coach Tony Giles worked with 5 churches and had a full roster of leaders asking for his services. We are in the initial stages of building a larger team to expand the program.

» In Japan, our renewal team supported 2 Sonship Weeks for Japanese church planters and leaders, one of which was completely in Japanese and led by people we've trained over the last 3 years. It's incredibly encouraging to see this movement of the gospel multiply and become locally led.

» In America, Renewal Area Director Patric Knaak produced 9 modules (nearly 400 pages of original content) of curriculum for our "Leadership Foundations" pilot cohort this year, in order to train the next generation of servant leaders within Serge. Next year, we will have two cohorts with Serge workers and hope to open up the opportunity for public registrations in 2021.

Holistic Healthcare in Action

"This young patient serves at the local church in Kijabe. My clinical officer spent the time to present the gospel and ask if he would like to accept Jesus into his heart.

Despite having served in the church and attended faithfully, he had never taken that step! We were able to pray with him to accept Jesus. We are so grateful for a hospital that doesn't only focus on the urgent physical illness, but remembers the important spiritual needs."

RENEWAL



YOUR GLOBAL IMPACT IN 2019

MORE THAN 300 MISSIONARIES IN OVER 25 COUNTRIES

In the U.S. and around the world, Serge missionaries are laying down their lives, every day and in the face of great brokenness, in order to share the gospel with others.

U.S.A.

Our Renewal Team produced 10 webinars this year, on topics including evangelism training, gospel-centered parenting, and the art of listening in discipleship. These webinars are having a deep impact in the lives and work of believers and Christian leaders, and are connecting new people to our work and resources.

PERU

In Cusco, new Serge workers joined the team this year one is serving as a dentist at Clinica La Fuente and another is assisting with launching Young Life in Cusco to develop relationships with the Peruvian university students. In Lima, Serge is working to support nationally led, church planting movements fueled by the gospel of grace throughout Central and South America.

Movements of grace reaching all people, renewing all believers, and restoring all things for the world's good and God's glory.

N. IRELAND AND IRELAND

New workers are on their way to Northern Ireland to mentor and resource new national church planters, existing pastors and leaders. This new collaboration is a testimony to the power of the gospel to unite the body of Christ for His mission

- NETHERLANDS

The Serge team continues to train Serge teams across the globe, leading workshops on evangelism and reaching culture through art to help develop deeper roots across the whole mission.

U.K. -----

One of our five teams in London has started a counseling service to serve non-believers in the large South Asian immigrant population. This community - which typically has little access to mental health services - is experiencing the tangible love of Christ through counsel and care.

GUATEMALA

A new team in Guatemala is providing health care in the impoverished neighborhood located on top of the city dump. They are encouraging holistic health development and disease prevention in the community while also teaching counseling and mental health to local pastors.

CHILE

The team is helping to renew local churches by mentoring national pastors, reconnecting them to the gospel, and equipping them with gospel-based resources - so they can grow healthy churches, make new disciples, and see the gospel transform their communities.

CZECH REPUBLIC

With the launch of our new Prague Apprenticeship site, Serge leaders are providing personal mentoring and training for the next generation of missionaries as they experience hands-on ministry service and cross-cultural living. The apprenticeship works in partnership with our two thriving church plants.

ROMANIA

Our team in Cluj is serving the community that lives in Pata Rât landfill, the largest waste-related ghetto in Europe. They are ministering to teenage mothers, families in poverty, and teaching teens art and practical trade skills - all while showering them with the love of Jesus.

SOUTH SUDAN

Although our team of missionaries had to evacuate due to ongoing civil unrest, we are finding ways to serve the South Sudanese diaspora, particularly through seminary training of their emerging church leaders.

KENYA

New workers have joined the growing Kijabe team and are starting new ventures, including opening a coffee shop, providing jobs for the Kijabe community, and selling the sewing projects made by women in order to keep them out of the sex trade. The medical workers on the team are performing an unprecedented number of surgeries, as the hospital expands from 8 operating rooms to 15 over the next 2 years.

BURUNDI

A new solar power field came online last year at Kibuye Hope Hospital, making the hospital 100% solar powered! As a result of reliable power now available, the death rate among the newborns on oxygen and incubators has dramatically fallen and made for safer surgeries.

UGANDA

In Uganda, Christ School Bundibugyo celebrated its 20-year anniversary and continues to rank in the top 15% of schools nationally. Graduates are serving as pastors, nurses, teachers and doctors, helping to transform their community in one of the least accessible, and desperately needy places in the world.

NORTH AFRICA

Our three businesses are thriving, generating new opportunities to discuss faith with employees and others in their community. We are eagerly looking for the next business opportunity to build a gospel community in this unique spiritual landscape.

God is expanding our work in Spain, with a new team in Màlaga focused on mentoring Spanish church planters, creating bridges from local churches to the community through English Camps, and offering revitalizing Sonship Retreats for national pastors and their families. This is our fourth team in Spain.

SPAIN -----

D.R. CONGO

Serge has a growing medical team in DRC, and after weathering an emergency evacuation, they are resettling to enter the DRC this year - to continue training midwives and offering critical care at a remote outpost clinic.

MIDDLE EAST

Our teams are working to start new are spiritually hungry. We are already and counseling, and have another

Each one of these dots tells about the work we do, the challenges our workers face, and the way God is working through supporters like you to grow His Kingdom.

The team serves the city through life coaching and discipling, missionary care, and trainings for Christian workers. They are also involved in outreach through an English Cafe, providing individual discipleship meetings and job training for former prostitutes.

> In South Asia, we've opened a second freedom bakery location, and in its first year, it has become even more profitable than the first one! Both bakeries provide much needed employment and spiritual hope to women, who live in a local brothel, and who have begun house churches with their friends still stuck in prostitution.

EAST ASIA

God has sustained our Business for Transformation teams in this region in the midst of difficulty and suffering. Serge workers have been ministering to other believers as they also navigate loss and uncertainty.

JAPAN

In Japan, where only 1% of the population is Christian, there's been a growing grace-renewal movement. Serge workers are helping to develop the next generation of Japanese church leaders, and leading "Grace Weeks" to strengthen and refresh other Kingdom workers who are planting churches.

SOUTHEAST ASIA

New Businesses for Transformation are being formed to reach out to those needing care physically, mentally, and spiritually. The people are hungry for the gospel, thus our present businesses are growing despite local and team pressures.

> Not all locations are listed due to missionaries serving in fields where great sensitivity is required.

BUSINESS FOR TRANSFORMATION

Opening Doors for the Gospel in Closed Countries

» A new B4T Area Director has been appointed to see Kingdom growth in this key area of our work. This seasoned disciple and experienced businessman will help us expand our B4T footprint. He will proactively generate new opportunities and recruit new entrepreneurs - in order to open doors for the Kingdom into unreached places for social, spiritual, and economic transformation.

» Your support helped us launch a NEW business in S.E. Asia that will provide bi-vocational pastors and church planters with much-needed employment. Many of these pastors struggle to find work that gives them enough flexibility. This new business will make a huge difference in their ability to sustain their churches and plant new ones.

» In North Africa, despite having a season of struggles, the laundry business was successfully sold to a local believer and businessman, and is continuing as a Christian business, with all jobs preserved. The missionary-entrepreneurial couple who started the business is now looking for their next project.

» The Arts Business in North Africa just celebrated its 5-year anniversary, and has recently seen a big increase in local people who are open and responsive to talk about faith. After 5 years, their relationships with the community have deepened – which has allowed them to witness more people coming to faith, the growth of home fellowships, and fruitful mentoring of local church leaders.






SHORT-TERM MISSIONS

» You've sent 27 interns and 10 Apprentices to the field this year, enabling a new generation of Christians to be discipled in Sonship and applying God's grace in the midst of cross-cultural missions.

» We've launched a new Apprenticeship site in Prague. Of the 62 American apprentices who've arrived on the field since 2011, a full 25% have arrived during this last fiscal year! We currently have 31 apprentices serving in 7 countries, including our new apprenticeship field in Prague.

» We launched over 9 Short-Term Teams this year. One of which was our first ever multi-national, shortterm team – people from both Chile and the U.S. went to Litein, Kenya to renovate a house for a new Serge medical team.





MISSIONARY CARE

Caring for and Empowering Missionaries for Greater Gospel Impact

» This past year, your support enabled us to launch a new initiative called Launch Week. It is one piece of an effort to even better prepare our missionaries to apply the gospel to common challenges they will face on the field.

» You've helped us lead 2 Area Spiritual Retreats for our workers in East/Central Africa and Latin America. These vital retreats serve our workers by providing much-needed rest and renewal in the gospel, encouraging, strengthening, sharpening and building them together in their shared labor for the kingdom.

» Your support has helped us launch a new Learning Management System called "Serge Academy." This online, video-based, self-study tool is a robust and scalable way to deliver training and professional development to our workers who are spread out over 25 countries on 5 continents. As we grow, this will be instrumental in ensure Serge values and culture continue in our work throughout the globe.

» Because MK Teachers touch so many of our missionary kids' lives in such a huge way, Serge Overseas Educational Advisor has been equipping and supporting MK Teachers with the tools and resources they need to help MK's thrive both academically and emotionally on the field.

So Many Gods!

Leila* was one of the first women Katie* hired from the neighborhood. She was eager to leave the darkness of life in the sex trade for the chance at a new life. Now several years later, Leila has learned how to bake pastries to sell in the busy cafe located in a big city in S.E. Asia. Working alongside both expat and national believers, she has gotten a taste of what it's like to work in an environment where there is business integrity, personal care and development for the workers, and lots of laughter! Very different from the life of her past.

This week Leila said to Katie, who is her supervisor, "All these gods...they don't see me. JESUS sees me! These gods...they don't understand me. JESUS understands me! I believe Jesus loves me, and I want to know what it means to follow Him. And I want my son to know Him too!"
